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ELIGIBILITY

- Middle and high school students enrolled in Korean classes or Korean culture classes in public school
- If you attended school in Korea, you must have attended school in the United States for at least four years.
- **Please inform your teacher** that you want to participate in this contest. Korean class / Korean culture class teacher must submit a recommendation form for you through the teacher's Google form. (<https://forms.gle/RdxndPd6Wbci8K2b8>)



AWARD CATEGORY

- **Hangul Grand Award (1st)**
\$1,000 Scholarship + Certificate of Student Interpreter
- **King Sejong Award (2nd)**
\$500 Scholarship + Certificate of Student Interpreter
- **Hunminjeongeum Award (3rd)**
\$300 Scholarship + Certificate of Student Ambassador for Korean Culture

Winners will be given the opportunity to serve as interpreters and public relations ambassadors at KECLA-hosted and sponsored events.





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CONTEST SCHEDULE

CONTEST PROCESS

- **1st Review** Script Evaluation (50 pts)
- **Final Review** Presentation Evaluation (50 pts)
6/15 (Sat) 1 PM ~ 4 PM at KECLA



SCRIPT EVALUATION (50 PTS)

- Imagine you are doing a presentation **promoting** the Korean culture you love to people without knowledge about the Korean culture, and **write a script** for your presentation.
- **Korean culture example:** modern, tradition, history, place, person, story, entertainment, technology, custom, food, music, game, etc.
- **Review criteria:** originality, clear reason, strong support, and overall writing





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SCRIPT EVALUATION (50 PTS)

- Two pages, Times New Roman, font size 12
- **Be concise.** You will be given **5min** to present your material. If your script is too lengthy, you won't be able to finish in time.
- Write in **Korean** or **English** (or a mix of **both**)
- You can hand-write the Korean part if you do not know how to type in Korean. If you hand-write it, please scan and upload it as a PDF file.
- **Save your script as** First Name_Last Name_School
- Submit by **5/13 (Mon)** by Student Application Google Form (<https://forms.gle/6b33aUuZCsFaZ3B19>)



PRESENTATION EVALUATION (50 PTS)

Presentation Material

- Those who pass the script review must submit a presentation material by 6/10.
- Presentation material format: PowerPoint, Google Slide, PDF
- All the participants must use the KECLA device. Therefore, please refrain from using effects and animation.
- Save your presentation as: First Name_Last Name_School





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PRESENTATION EVALUATION (50 PTS)

Contest Format

- Must present at the in-person contest on 6/15 (Sat) 1 PM ~4 PM at KECLA
- 5 min Presentation
Cannot exceed 7 min, including preparation and exit
- Introduce and promote the Korean culture you love as if you are explaining it to people without knowledge of Korean culture.
- Present in English, Korean, or a mix of both.
(Extra points are applied depending on the ratio of Korean used.)
- You can use costumes and props.



PRESENTATION EVALUATION (50 PTS)

Contest Format

- Review criteria: content and composition, speech delivery and accuracy, attitude, ratio of Korean used
- After the last presentation, the evaluation scores will be tallied, and the evaluation results will be announced.
