

>> Requirements & Eligibilities

- 1. Both the applicant and the applicant's parent(s) must be non-Korean citizens
- Applicant must complete primary and secondary education equivalent to grade 1 to 12 in the Korean education system, either in Korea or overseas
- 3. Applicant must submit the result of either an English or Korean language proficiency test


